

Cookie policy

This policy describes the general terms of using cookie files on the website www.taxters.com the types of cookie files, their designation and the manner you can control them.

By using different cookie files, we improve quality of your interaction with our website. Please allow us to record your preferences.

What is a cookie file?

A cookie is a small piece of data in form of text or binary code saved on your device (tablet, smartphone, computer) when visiting our website. When repeatedly visiting the website, your browser transmits the information in the opposite direction. In this way we can identify you and make your stay on our website as comfort as possible, by adjusting interface according to your preferences and interests.

What types of cookie files we use and why?

We use several types of cookie files:

- Sessional – used for storage and identification of the unique identifier of the user’s session with an aim to manage the session on the website. These cookie files are being deleted when closing all browsing windows;
- Functional – responsible for functionality of additional features of our website, e.g. for storage of your language preferences. These cookies improve interaction with the website;
- Analytical – they help us understand your specific point of interest on our website, e.g., which pages are most often visited. This gives us a chance to produce more useful content on the website.

Managing cookie files

If necessary, you may delete cookie files or turn them off. In order to do so, you should follow the instructions when configuring your browser.
